A fresh floral exhibit of garden flowers displayed in an unusual container. Accessories can be used but should not dominate.

Display size width 18" x depth 18" x height in proportion. Will be displayed on a dark coloured tablecloth and backdrop.

The staging to be completed on site by no more than 2 members, between the hours of 10am and noon on Tuesday 30th May. Some or all of your exhibit can be constructed in advance if you wish.

Exhibits may be moved by the Show Committee after judging. Please collect exhibits between 5.30 and 6.30pm on Thursday 1st June.

- 9. The judges' decision is **FINAL**. If any item is considered "Not as Schedule" then no marks will be awarded, and comments only given.
- 10. Entry forms to be sent to 22 Orford Street by Friday 10th February 2017. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 11. Entries that arrive after the closing date/time will not be judged.
- 12. In the unlikely event of having to withdraw your entry, please advise Gill Denny IN WRITING no later than 30th April 2017 for classes to be judged at Orford Street and at least ONE WEEK before the show for the flowers.
- 13. Exhibitors are asked to vacate the marquee <u>immediately</u> after staging their exhibits. Children or other unauthorised persons are not allowed in the marquee while staging is in progress.
- 14. Exhibits to be removed on Thursday 1st June between <u>5.30</u> and <u>6.30pm</u> and not before to comply with the Suffolk Agricultural Association regulations. Vehicular access to the showground is not allowed until after 7pm. The most successful way of collecting items is to park in the Bucklesham Road car park and carry your exhibits from the marquee. Some members find bringing a wheelbarrow in their car useful for this.

Landscape or portrait format, and can be taken any time of the year.
