A Playroom for a Dolls' House

60 Marks



Co-operative class for two or more members

**Create a child's playroom/bedroom/nursery for a dolls' house.
Maximum external measurements: 12" (30cm) wide, 9" (23cm) deep and 8" (20cm) high, walled, but not roofed or fronted (exterior of walls to be neatly finished)**

The overall look plus two individual items (one of which to be a hard craft) to be judged (20 marks each)

Additional items can be made for the room and will affect the "overall look" mark, but please indicate which items are to be judged.

To be at 22 Orford Street by 3pm Friday 11th May. Staging will be by the show committee. Judged by NFWI Craft judge according to "On With The Show"

Class 3 Marriage

**Flowers for the modern bride 20
Marks**

An exhibit using fresh flowers for a contemporary wedding. This may be a bouquet or a table display.

**Maximum space allowed 18 x 18" (45 x 45cm)
Height unlimited.
Maximum budget £20**



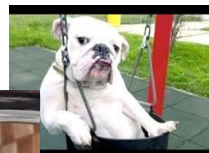
**Please provide means of displaying a bouquet to its best advantage

Notes for Entrants
Please read carefully

1. Entrance fee: £6 per class to be judged. One entry per class per WI allowed for judging and must be clearly labelled with WI name on a small label attached out of initial sight.

2. Classes to be received by 3pm Friday 11th May and judged at 22 Orford Street:
 - Class 1 Cover
 - Class 2 Playroom
 - Class 5 Poem

Class 4 Photo will be Public Choice only, but please bring to office by 25th May so we can plan the display.

3. Class to be judged at 12 noon on Tuesday 29th May at the showground:
 - Class 3 Flower exhibit

4. All Classes other than class 3 to be staged by the Suffolk Show committee.

5. Class 4 shall be voted by visitors for the Public Choice award.
 - Class 5 shall be judged but no numerical scores given.

6. All items must be the exhibitor's own work and not previously exhibited at a County Show.

7. All items displayed at owner's risk. The committee can take no responsibility for any loss or damage. Please be aware that items will be displayed in a damp marquee.

8. Classes, where appropriate, will be marked according to the NFWI Handbook, "*On with the Show*" (revised edition 2012). All revisions are available from 22 Orford Street or on NFWI Moodle, please contact Gill Denny for advice on registering for the Moodle. Please refer to the relevant sections when preparing your entry.

9. The judges' decision is **FINAL**. If any item is considered "Not as Schedule" then no marks will be awarded, and comments only given.

10. Entry forms to be sent to 22 Orford Street by Friday 9th February 2018. Late entries will not be accepted.

11. Entries that arrive after the closing date/time will not be judged.

12. In the unlikely event of having to withdraw your entry, please advise Gill Denny **IN WRITING** no later than 30th April 2018 for classes to be judged at Orford Street and at least **ONE WEEK** before the show for the flowers.

13. Exhibitors are asked to vacate the marquee immediately after staging their exhibits. Children or other unauthorised persons are not allowed in the marquee while staging is in progress.

14. Exhibits to be removed on Thursday 31st May between **6.00 and 6.30pm** and not before to comply with the Suffolk Agricultural Association regulations. Vehicular access to the showground is not allowed until after 7pm. The most successful way of collecting items is to park in the Bucklesham Road car park and carry your exhibits from the marquee. Some members find bringing a wheelbarrow in their car useful for this.
