10. Entry forms to be sent to 22 Orford Street by Friday 8th February 2019. Late entries will not be accepted.

11. Entries that arrive after the closing date/time will not be judged.

12. In the unlikely event of having to withdraw your entry, please advise Gill Denny **IN WRITING** no later than 30th April 2019 for classes to be judged at Orford Street and at least **ONE WEEK** before the show for the flowers.

13. Exhibitors are asked to vacate the marquee immediately after staging their exhibits. Children or other unauthorised persons are not allowed in the marquee while staging is in progress.

14. Exhibits to be removed on Thursday 1st June between 6.00 and 6.30pm and not before to comply with the Suffolk Agricultural Association regulations. Vehicular access to the showground is not allowed until after 7pm. The most successful way of collecting items is to park in the Bucklesham Road car park and carry your exhibits from the marquee. Some members find bringing a wheelbarrow in their car useful for this.

Class 2 Gift for a Party

60 marks (20 each for preserves, 20 for gift exhibit)

A gift of preserves

Two jars of different preserves presented as a gift.

Two full size jars (min ½lb—max 1lb) of each preserve to be submitted—one of each to be already presented as the gift, the other two jars for judging by a NFWI Qualified preserves judge, according to On with the Show, who will then judge the overall look of the gift.

No additional food items to be included in the gift package, but gift accessories may be used.

Label each jar being judged AND the gift exhibit with the WI name on the base.

To be at 22 Orford Street by 3pm Friday 10th May. Staging will be by the show committee.

The judged jars will be returned to the WI at the earliest convenience.

Please collect exhibit between 6.00 and 6.30pm on Thursday 1st June

Must be self-supporting

To be brought to the showground on Tuesday 30th May by no more than two members between the hours of 10am and noon on that date.

Exhibits may be moved by Show committee.

To be judged by Public Choice only.

Please collect exhibit between 6.00 and 6.30pm on Thursday 1st June.



Notes for Entrants Please read carefully

1. Entrance fee: £6 per class or £15 for all three classes. One entry per class per WI allowed for judging and must be clearly labelled with WI name on a small label attached out of initial sight.
2. Classes to be received by 3pm Friday 10th May and judged at 22 Orford Street:
Class 2 Gift of preserves
3. Class to be judged at 12 noon on Tuesday 30th May at the showground:
Class 1 Flower exhibit
4. All Classes to be staged by the Suffolk Show committee.
5. Class 3 shall be voted for by visitors for the Public Choice award.
6. All items must be the exhibitor's own work and not previously exhibited at a County Show.
7. All items displayed at owner's risk. The committee can take no responsibility for any loss or damage. Please be aware that items will be displayed in a damp marquee.
8. Classes, where appropriate, will be marked according to the NFWI Handbook, "*On with the Show*" (revised edition 2012). All revisions are available from 22 Orford Street or on MyWI please contact Gill Denny for advice on registering for MyWI. Please refer to the relevant sections when preparing your entry.
9. The judges' decision is **FINAL**. If any item is considered "Not as Schedule" then no marks will be awarded, and comments only given.
