A floral exhibit

20 Marks

An exhibit using fresh flowers

Maximum space allowed 18 x 18" (45 x 45cm) on a grey clothed table with back board.

Height unlimited.

Accessories may be used but must not dominate.

To be brought to Suffolk One on Friday 17th July by no more than two members between the hours of 1 and 2.30pm on that date.

Exhibits may be moved by Show committee after judging. Judged by NFWI Flower judge according to "On with the Show"

Class 2 Picnic

A decorated cake

20 Marks

To be presented on a board not larger than 12" (30cm) in any direction (supplied by exhibitor)

Cake must be large enough to serve minimum 8 people, although cake will not be cut—judged on decoration only.

To be brought to Suffolk One on Friday 17th July by no more than two members between the hours of 1 and 2.30pm on that date.

Exhibits may be moved by Show committee after judging. Judged by NFWI Craft judge according to "On with the Show"

Please collect exhibit between 3 and 4pm on Sunday 19th July

Class 3 Time for Tea

A baking, preserves and staging co-operative, scones 20 marks, preserve 20 marks, staging 20 marks
Total 60 Marks

A Pair of Scones with Preserve, can be sweet or savoury (check with “On with the Show” for full definition of a preserve).

To be staged on a 12” (30cm) round or square board supplied by exhibitor.

The jar of preserve (minimum ½lb size) to be brought to Orford Street by 3pm on 26th June for pre-judging.

The remainder of the entry to be brought to Suffolk One on Friday 17th July by no more that two members between the hours of 1 and 2.30pm on that date for staging.

Exhibits may be moved by Show committee after judging. Judged by NFWI cookery and staging judge according to “On with the Show”.

Please collect exhibit between 3 and 4pm on Sunday 19th July

Class 4 A Summer Occasion

A Jewellery Set 20 Marks

A necklace and earring set suitable for a summer occasion.

Please display your work on a suitable mount.

To be brought to WI office, 22 Orford Street, Ipswich by 3pm on 26th June for judging before the show.

This class will be staged by the show committee.

Judged by NFWI Craft judge according to “On with the Show”

Class 5 A Summer’s Day

A Work of Art

A piece of artwork no larger than A3 in size (approx: 42 x 30cm, 17 x 12 inches)

A painting or drawing on an appropriate stretched canvas or paper. If using stretched canvas, no additional frame is required. A support for displaying (desk-top easel or similar) to be supplied by exhibitor.

To be brought to WI office, 22 Orford Street, Ipswich by 3pm on 26th June for judging before the show.

This class will be staged by the show committee.

Judged by appropriate artistic judge with comments only.

Please collect exhibit between 3 and 4pm on Sunday 19th July

Class 6 Summer Blooms

Knitting and crochet 20 Marks

Three knitted or crocheted flowers on stems presented in a vase (supplied by exhibitor). Flower stems must be removable from the vase.

To be brought to WI office, 22 Orford Street, Ipswich by 3pm on 26th June for judging before the show.

This class will be staged by the show committee.

Judged by NFWI craft judge according to “On with the Show”

Please collect exhibit between 3 and 4pm on Sunday 19th July

Notes for Entrants

Please read carefully

1. Entrance fee: £5 per class (or £25 for all 6 classes). One entry per class per WI allowed and must be clearly labelled with WI name on a small label attached out of initial sight.
2. Classes to be received by 3pm Friday 26th June and judged at 22 Orford Street:
 - Class 3 Preserve element
 - Class 4 Jewellery
 - Class 5 Work of art
 - Class 6 Knitted/crocheted flowers
3. Class to be judged at 2.30pm at Suffolk One:
 - Class 1 Flower exhibit
 - Class 2 Decorated cake
 - Class 3 Scones and Staging
4. All Classes other than class 3 to be staged by the Show committee.
5. All items must be the exhibitor's own work and not previously exhibited at a County Show.
6. All items displayed at owner's risk. The committee can take no responsibility for any loss or damage, although security at the school is very good.
7. Classes, where appropriate, will be marked according to the NFWI Handbook, "On with the Show" (2015 edition with 2017 revisions). All revisions are available on NFWI MyWI, please contact Gill Denny for advice on registering for MyWI. Please refer to the relevant sections when preparing your entry.
8. The judges' decision is FINAL. If any item is considered "Not as Schedule" then no marks will be awarded, and comments only given.
9. Entry forms to be sent to 22 Orford Street by Friday 27th March 2020. Late entries will not be accepted.
10. Entries that arrive after the closing date/time will not be judged.
11. In the unlikely event of having to withdraw your entry, please advise Gill Denny at least ONE WEEK before due date.
12. Exhibitors are asked to vacate the hall immediately after staging their exhibits. Children or other unauthorised persons are not allowed in the hall while staging is in progress.
13. Exhibits to be removed on Sunday 19th July between 3 and 4pm
