**Prizes are as follows:**

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize:** £100 + a 12-month free membership of The Suffolk Family History Society.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:** £50 + a 12-month free membership of The Suffolk Family History Society.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Prize:** a 12-month free membership of The Suffolk Family History Society.

**Deadline for submissions:** all entries must be received by the **31<sup>st</sup> August**. Entries received after this date will not be considered.

- 1) We would like to publish the winner and runner's up entries in a forthcoming issue (or issues) of the Suffolk Family History Society "Suffolk Roots" quarterly Journal. These articles will also be offered to the East and West Suffolk W.I. for publication in their magazines. Submission of an entry confers the right to Suffolk family History Society to publish winning articles in the Society's Journal, "Suffolk Roots". Authors of those articles will be entitled to 5 copies of the Journal in which their article appears.
- 2) Copyright of the published articles will be held jointly by the author and Suffolk family History Society.
- 3) The winning articles will be offered back to the W.I. team for them to be published in the W.I. magazines, after they have appeared in "Suffolk Roots".
- 4) Entries must be received by **31<sup>st</sup> August**. Any late entries received after this date will not be judged in connection with the competition, but may still be considered for publication in Suffolk Roots.
- 5) The article must be original work of the author or be submitted with the author's permission if entered by another person.
- 6) All living persons mentioned in the article must have given their permission for data or other information to be mentioned in the article.
- 7) Articles submitted are only accepted on the understanding that they will be subject to the society's normal editorial process before being published in Suffolk Roots. In the case of a lengthy article, the society reserves the editorial right to divide the article into one or more Journal issues.
- 8) The article must not have been previously published.
- 9) We cannot guarantee to return any paper submissions.
